

## CNA Instructor Job Description

## Job Description:

This position seeks a CNA Instructor (LPN or RN) to effectively teach students by utilizing the state curriculum in conjunction with training on the required skills in the clinical and lab setting. Providing instructional materials and evaluation tools to ensure the guidelines of the curriculum is being met is key. The instructor must be committed in helping students gain knowledge and experience during the program.

## **Minimum Qualifications:**

Classroom Instruction - Teaching the didactic portion of the 105 hours of the CNA program requires an instructor to meet all three of the following criteria:

1 - Must be a Licensed Registered Nurse (RN) or Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) holding an unencumbered license in the state of Indiana;

2- Must have a minimum one year of nursing experience and

3) Completed the state required Nurse Aide Instructor Train the Trainer seminar or willing to obtain at time of hire.

Clinical Practicum - Teaching the clinical portion of the 105 hours of the CNA program requires the instructor to meet both of the following criteria: 1 - Must be a Licensed Registered Nurse (RN) or Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) holding an unencumbered license in the state of Indiana; 2 - Must have a minimum of one year experience as a licensed nurse.
